



THE MALTON JOURNEY

The staff at Malton highlighted a need to enhance collaboration between students and teachers to help engage learners within lessons. Staff were keen to embrace and keep up with the changes in technology and how these are continuously impacting education.



THE SOLUTION

The school was presented with a choice of devices to help them achieve their end goal – and after a thorough selection process, the senior leadership at Malton considered iPad mini as the most suitable device due to the compactness, weight and screen size.

iPad also features many useful apps for the classroom including Book Creator, Showbie, Explain Everything, Socrative and Evernote. The staff needed iPad to help provide students with immediate feedback to assignments, enhance student engagement, improve digital literacy skills and give students more choice with regards to producing and presenting their work.

Malton opted for a 1:1 deployment scheme, putting a device in the hands of each student. Deploying 700 iPad devices is a big project to manage, but something Academia is well accomplished in. Academia provided a deployment service which included mobile device management plus a comprehensive training plan for faculty and students. The student training took place during the deployment period which ensured they were able to hit the ground running and benefit from the technology straight away.

HOW DID THE TRAINING PLAN WORK?

All students who were given a device received training regularly throughout the school year. Digital leaders aged between 14-16 years were identified and asked to support the wider student body, ensuring on-site 'experts' were empowered to learn. This was also showcased during Parents evenings and Open evenings, leading to enhanced parent-teacher collaboration.



"The teaching staff and support staff also benefitted from ongoing basis CPD sessions and departmental training – an element that is ongoing and part of the service from Academia."

OUTCOMES

Malton School's Ofsted report highlighted the advantageous use of iPad in the curriculum and noted that the mobile device implementation had helped to transform the school's learning environment and helped streamline content sharing between students, teachers and parents.

Students were surveyed and the results show that nearly 80% of Year 10 and 70% of Year 11 students felt that iPad devices had a positive impact upon their learning. Students are using iPad in lessons to research more quickly, which in turn is helping them to become more independent learners.

From a teacher perspective, the successful iPad implementation has enabled teachers to provide effective and personalised feedback to students more easily. This is enhancing student engagement and in turn, their learning.
